### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Cut the paper plate into three equal triangle shapes. (It will be easier if you use a ruler and pencil to trace lines on the plate to divide it in thirds). To make the "top" of the tree, trim a bit of the sides off of one triangle to make it a little smaller than the other two triangles.
- 2. Use glue and tape to attach the two bigger triangles together to make the middle and bottom of the tree. Then, attach the smaller top of the tree to the other triangles.
- 3. Cut out a rectangle from the brown construction paper to make the tree trunk and glue or tape it to the bottom plate.
- 4. Glue curly ribbons, pom poms, sequins, stickers, foam shapes, or whatever you like onto your tree to trim it with ornaments and decorations! Did you put a star on the top?
