

# Craft Owl

## SUPPLIES:

- Brown, black, and orange construction paper
- Two cupcake liners
- Leaves, real or synthetic
- Glue
- Scissors



## DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut out the shape of an owl's body from brown construction paper. Then cut out two more paper shapes for wings.
2. Glue two cupcake liners onto the body for the eyes. Cut out two small circles, about the size of a penny, from black paper and glue them into the middle of the cupcake liners to make pupils.
3. Cut out a small orange triangle and glue it on to make a beak.
4. If you want to give your owl a feathery texture with some fall flair, glue some leaves onto the wings and tummy or even the ears!
