Craft Owl

SUPPLIES:

- •Brown, black, and orange construction paper
- •Two cupcake liners
- •Leaves, real or synthetic
- •Glue
- Scissors



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut out the shape of an owl's body from brown construction paper. Then cut out two more paper shapes for wings.
- 2. Glue two cupcake liners onto the body for the eyes. Cut out two small circles, about the size of a penny, from black paper and glue them into the middle of the cupcake liners to make pupils.
- 3. Cut out a small orange triangle and glue it on to make a beak.
- 4. If you want to give your owl a feathery texture with some fall flair, glue some leaves onto the wings and tummy or even the ears!
