Scarecrow

SUPPLIES:

- 5 Jumbo popsicle sticks
- Brown paint, crayons, or markers
- Glue
- Colored paper, cardstock, or construction
- paper
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Embellishments like glitter, small stickers, etc.



DIRECTIONS:

1. Paint or color two of the popsicle sticks brown and set them aside.

2. Glue the remaining three popsicle sticks together in the shape of a triangle.

3. While the triangle is drying, choose a sheet of colored paper for your scarecrow's body. Cut out a large triangle that will fit inside the popsicle stick design you just made.

4. Now grab your remaining paper and cut out a head, hat, and anything else you think your scarecrow needs.

5. Draw a face on the head with markers or crayons.

6. When the popsicle stick triangle shape is dry enough, glue all the paper pieces you just made in their designated spots.

7. Glue the two brown painted popsicle sticks to the back of the decorated triangle shape to make arms and the stick that holds the puppet together.

8. Add any other decorations you like, such as stickers, sequins, straw, or buttons.

9. Let it dry thoroughly, then play with your puppet!
