## **Cupcake Liner Jellyfish**





Cupcake liner
Scissors
Glue or tape
crepe paper streamers, ribbons or tissue paper
12 in. yarn or string
Googly eyes
Markers

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Poke a small hole in the middle of the cupcake liner.
- 2. Tie a knot at the end of the yarn and thread though the hole. The knot will be on the inside. Secure with tape.
- 3. Cut tentacles from colored tissue, crepe paper or ribbon. Will your jellyfish have the smae length tentacles or will you make some longer and some shorter?
- 4. Glue or tape one end of your tentacles to the inside of the cupcake liner.
