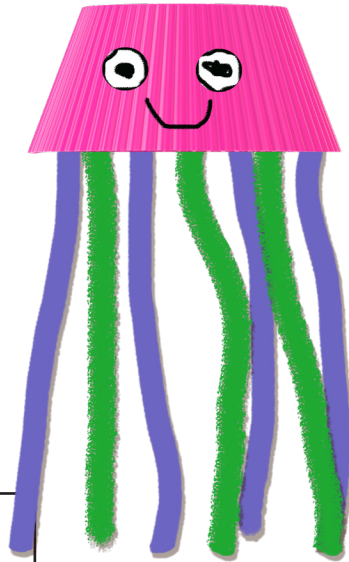


Cupcake Liner Jellyfish



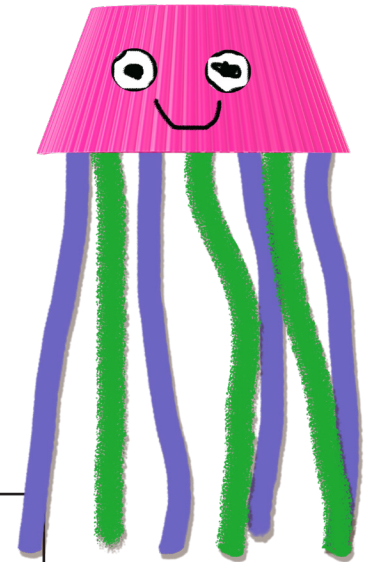
SUPPLIES:

Cupcake liner
Scissors
Glue or tape
crepe paper streamers, ribbons or tissue paper
12 in. yarn or string
Googly eyes
Markers

DIRECTIONS:

1. Poke a small hole in the middle of the cupcake liner.
2. Tie a knot at the end of the yarn and thread through the hole. The knot will be on the inside. Secure with tape.
3. Cut tentacles from colored tissue, crepe paper or ribbon. Will your jellyfish have the same length tentacles or will you make some longer and some shorter?
4. Glue or tape one end of your tentacles to the inside of the cupcake liner.
5. Flip the cupcake liner over so the tentacles dangle down. Make a face with googly eyes or other decorations.
6. Make the jellyfish by holding the yarn and wiggling it around or hang it as a decoration.
