Tie Dye Coaster

SUPPLIES:

1 ceramic tile
A few different colored Sharpies or
permanent markers
1 pipette
1 paper plate
1 small paper cup
Rubbing alcohol (not included)
Modge podge
A paintbrush
Felt dots

Please note:

Take your time and enjoy watching the colors change, spread and settle with this craft. This project requires patience, and should not be rushed. If you are unhappy with how your tile looks, you can completely wipe off the Sharpie to start again with a clean slate at any time before sealing the design. Please complete this craft in a well-ventilated area.



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Use the sharpies to make a design of your choice on the ceramic tile. Try to leave little to no white space on the tile.
- 2. Place your fully colored tile on a paper plate.
- 3. Pour a little rubbing alcohol into the paper cup, about 1-2 tablespoons should be enough.
- 4. Use the pipette to drip the rubbing alcohol onto the tile. The more rubbing alcohol dripped in an area will create more white space. This is a slow process, carefully and patiently drip the rubbing alcohol onto the tile until you have a design you like.
- 5. Let the tile dry completely.
- 6. Using a paint brush carefully spread the modge podge over your tile to seal the design. Note: spreading the modge podge may cause the ink to bleed and change from your original design. Apply as many coats of modge podge as you'd like.
- 7. When the tile is dry, carefully flip the tile over and attach the felt dots in the four corners of the tile, this will prevent the coaster from scratching any surfaces.
- 8. Enjoy your new coaster!
