- 1 regular sized paper drinking cup
- 1 balloon
- Scissors
- Paint, markers, stickers, glitter glue, or whatever you desire for decorating the cup
- Pom poms, marshmallows, or other small objects for popping out of the cup





- 1. Decorate the outside of your cup however you like.
- 2. Have a grown up help cut out the bottom circle of the cup.
- 3. Tie a knot in the balloon at the bottom and snip off the top part just across the top.
