## "It's Time for S'more Books"



Cotton ball

Supplies:

- Larae popsicle stick
- Light and dark brown felt, foam, or paper (you can color paper if needed)
- Small piece of paper that says, "It's Time for S'more Books"
- Clothespin
- Stick-on magnet strip
- Glue

## Directions:

1. Glue the piece of paper that says, "It's Time for S'More Books," to the shaped end of the popsicle stick. If you are using your materials, cut out a small shape of paper, and decorate it to glue to one end of the stick.

2. Glue the clothespin onto the popsicle stick below the "It's Time for S'More Books" paper.

3. Next create the s'more by gluing together a 2-inch square of light brown felt or paper for the bottom graham cracker, a 2-inch dark brown square of felt or paper for the chocolate, a cotton ball for the marshmallow and another 2-inch square of light brown felt or paper for the top graham cracker.

4. Glue the s'more to the top of the clothespin.

5. Stick the magnet strip onto the back of the popsicle stick. You can use glue to make the magnet stick better.

6. Place your magnet on the fridge and use the clothespin to clip important papers up, such as the due date receipts for your library books.
