

DIY MORSE CODE BRACELET

Wear a secret message in public. This project is totally customizable.



- SUPPLIES:**
- Cord
 - Round beads (for the dots)
 - Long beads (for the dashes)
 - Lobster clasp
 - Scissors (not included)



DIRECTIONS:

1. First, plan out your Morse code using the chart, some ideas are included, but you could spell out your name or a favorite saying.
2. Next, prepare your cord. You will want a long piece, enough to wrap around your wrist one and a half times or about 10 inches.
3. Tie a knot in the middle and start to string your beads.
4. When you're done, tie another knot at the end of the beads to keep them in place.
5. The clasp is optional, if you do not want to have a clasp, close the bracelet by tying it with a knot. Make sure you can get it over your wrist.
6. If you want a clasp, measure out where the ends of the bracelet should be, tie on the clasp, and trim the extra cord.
