

Plush Pastry

Make a sweet treat for your desk! This is a simple craft that should take about 30 minutes to complete. The instructions are to make one large pastry plush, but you could make two smaller pastries with the supplies provided.

SUPPLIES:

- 1 piece of beige felt
- 1 piece of colored felt
- Polyfill stuffing
- Pom-poms
- Glue
- Scissors (not provided)



DIRECTIONS:

1. Fold the beige felt in half to make a 6" x 8" piece.
 - To make two smaller pastries, cut this large folded piece evenly to make two 4" x 6" pieces.
2. Sandwich some polyfill stuffing between the folded halves of fabric. You will want to fluff and stretch out the filling.
3. Glue the halves together at the edges as close as you can, pocketing the filling inside.
4. Cut an irregular rectangle shape from the colored felt, with smooth serpentine sides. This piece should, when placed on the beige felt leave about half an inch on all sides.
 - For the smaller pastries, fold the colored felt and cut it in half and complete step four.
5. Glue the colored felt to the main body of the plush. Be generous with the glue.
6. Let it sit to dry before putting the pom-poms on. If the colored piece is not drying onto the beige piece try setting something, like a box, on the project to squish it together.
7. Glue on pom-poms and let the project dry.
