

# AIR DRY CLAY PINCH POTS & MACRAMÉ HANGER

Decorate your space with a little clay pot and macramé hanging of your own design! Put a little plant or any small treasures in your clay pot to complete the look! This project will take about 20 minutes or so for each part, but the clay will need 24 hours to dry.



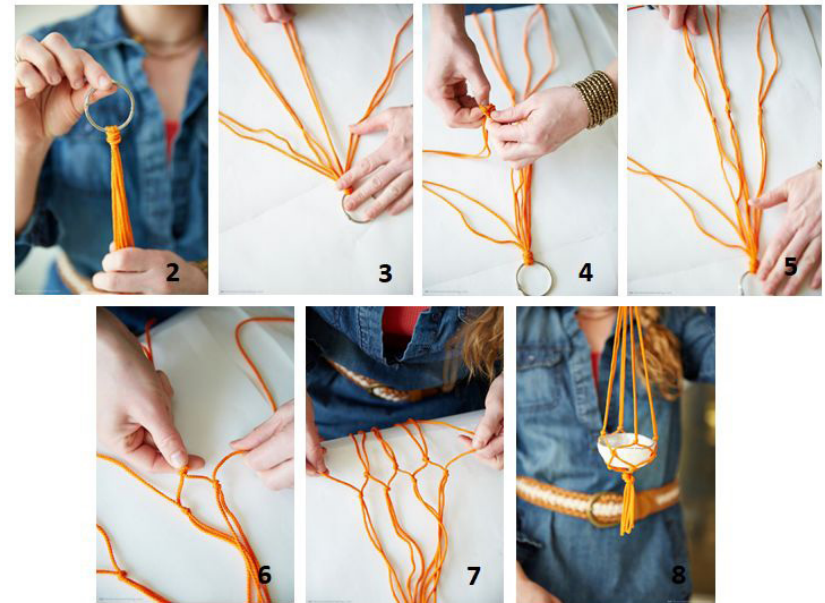
## SUPPLIES:

- Crayola air dry clay
- Sandpaper
- Modge podge
- Paint brush
- Sharpie or paint (not included)
- Rope
- Wooden ring



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PINCH POT:

1. Using a small ball of Crayola Air-Dry Clay, poke a hole in the middle with your thumb and shape into a little pot or dish.
2. Put your clay dish in a safe place to dry where it won't be disturbed.
3. Once the clay is dry, which takes about 24 hours, lightly sand it to smooth out any rough spots.
4. Decorate your pot using permanent markers. If you have any paints, or nail polish you'd like to use, that will work.
5. Paint a layer of modge podge on the dish when you're ready.



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE MACRAMÉ HANGER:

1. Start with four strings or cords cut a little more than double the desired length of your hanger.
2. Next, fold the eight strands in half. Poke the looped end through your ring, and pull the loose ends through that loop.
3. Separate your strands into pairs.
4. Decide where you want your planter to "sit"—and at that point, tie a simple overhand knot in each pair of strands. (Make sure your knots are all the same distance from the ring.)
5. Lay your planter flat and separate your strands. Match one strand from each pair with a strand from an adjacent (neighboring) pair.
6. Tie another overhand knot in each new pair 1"—2" inches down from the first knot.
7. Split the pairs again, and tie more knots another 1"—2" down.
8. Then gather all the strands together 1"—3" below the last knots and gather them all in a single overhand knot. Trim the ends as long or short as you'd like.
9. Add your planter, hang, and admire!
