ANNUAL BONFIRE PERMIT APPLICATION

Permit Expires December 31st of the Year of Issue

Payment must be made at time of application. No refunds will be issued.

Please allow 2-3 business days for permit approval

The following conditions shall be complied with for a Bonfire Permit.

1. Bonfires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material.
2. Bonfires shall be in a pit no larger than 5' x 5' wide and no less than 6" deep.
3. The pit will be bordered with a non-combustible, such as rock, block, or brick.
4. A garden hose or fire extinguisher will be accessible and near the bonfire.
5. **Only dried firewood logs or charcoal shall be burned for recreational purposes only. Not for burning of debris and yard waste.**
6. If a bonfire becomes out of hand or a nuisance, it may have to be extinguished, with the possibility of revoking the annual permit.
7. Bonfires shall not be allowed to burn before 12:00 p.m. (noon) or after 11:00 p.m.
8. Bonfires shall not be left unattended at any time.
