# Shelby Township built a 26,400-square-foot library without a tax increase

Shelby Township Board, staff address needs of growing community by more than doubling the size of library without debt or library millage







THE NEW LIBRARY INCREASES THE OLD FACILITY'S FOOTPRINT FROM 12,400 SQUARE FEET TO 26,400 SQUARE FEET.

While the COVID-19 pandemic delayed the new Shelby Township Library's opening, the project finished within budget. The 26,400-square-foot facility, the township's first standalone library, opened its doors June 25, 2022.



# LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION STAYED WITHIN ITS \$11.7 MILLION BUDGET, PAID IN CASH WITH NO DEBT, NO BONDING AND NO INCREASE IN TAXES.



Library landscaping added 53 trees, 120 shrubs, 67 evergreens, and 624 perennials and grasses to the campus.



The Children's Tree has 36 fireflies, four birds and three animals hiding in its limbs.




Nine meeting rooms range from the Legacy Room, the township's largest space, to five small semi-private study rooms.




The library sits under a standing seam roof and 12,600 square feet of

### Re: Celebrating a Year of Community and Connection

Dear Shelby Township neighbors:

As we celebrate our first anniversary in our beautiful new building, I look back on our remarkable journey of growth this year. The numbers are telling; painting the picture of a bustling community gathering place, learning space and community treasure.

Since our grand opening, the Shelby Township Library has stood as a beacon in our community embracing nearly 115,000 residents who walked through our welcoming doors. From our eager young readers, to lifelong learners, the numbers tell a story of success and engagement with a staggering 266,000 items checked out. This activity is a testament to the insatiable appetite for learning, culture and entertainment that resides within our community. We issued over 4,200 library cards to excited new users. We hosted 459 community programs that saw over 9,200 children, teens and adults visit the library in record numbers to enjoy our new programming spaces.

The numbers don't tell our complete story. Our residents are the main characters here. Our library staff loves watching patrons explore the new building with their mouths agape at our soaring wood ceilings. They're charmed by our beautiful seating areas awash in natural light from our panoramic windows that showcase our park setting.

Walk through our library any time of day and see every corner in use. By the fireplace, Jim reads a newspaper and swaps basketball stories with a fellow retired UCS teacher. Today, the dental and medical school students were the first in line for the private study rooms. The children's area is abuzz! Freshly arrived from feeding the ducks at Heritage Park, there are several sets of grandparents armed with juice boxes and sunscreen. They are guiding squirmy toddlers towards the Magic Book and Lego table. The Friends Corner Book Shop is busy with volunteers sorting donations and chatting with folks looking for a good deal on some gently used paperbacks they can take up north and leave behind in the cabin. In other corners of the library, there are book clubs, a writers group, a sensory-friendly movie screening, technology help, baby storytime and a dozen other tales underway.

This first year at your new Shelby Township Library was an incredible blockbuster, but truly, the story is just beginning. Join us for our next chapter...

The library's sense of community shines through author talks, book clubs and workshops, fostering connections and personal growth. Obtaining a library card isn't just about resources; it's joining a community that values learning. Discover enrichment and endless possibilities at the Shelby Township Library.

Visit the Shelby Township Library's 30-foot Children's Tree with 36 fireflies, four birds and three animals. We also have a one-of-a-kind interactive "magic book."

Browse our *graphic novels* and *manga* collection, and take your favorites to the teen room. Be sure to check out our interactive *Everbrite Wall*.

The library has a vast collection of adult and juvenile *DVDs*, *Blu-Ray* movies, TV shows and documentaries. We also have an extensive collection of *music CDs* and *audiobooks*.

### Fax

 The library sends domestic faxes for \$1 per page. The library does not receive faxes or send international faxes.
