Notice of withholding of Federal income tax from periodic payments

Generally, if you are a U.S. citizen or a resident alien, you are not permitted to elect not to have federal income tax withheld on payments to be delivered outside the United States and its territories. Also, if you elect not to have federal income tax withheld, you could be subject to a penalty tax for underpayment of taxes.

Federal tax withholding continued

Federal law requires that periodic payments you receive be subject to Federal income tax withholding. Withholding will only apply to the portion of your periodic payments that is already included in your income subject to Federal income tax and will be like wage withholding. You may change or revoke your previous election at any time by returning a signed and dated election form to the noted "Return form to" above address. Any election or revocation will become effective on either of the next two pay dates, depending on when your election form arrives in our office.
