Day 1

Our New England Extravaganza begins as you are met by our professional Bianco tour director and driver. A scenic drive will bring us to our home for the first night in Stroudsburg, PA. During our journey we will make plenty of stops to stretch and get something to eat. Be sure to get some rest as we are making our way to Newport, Rhode Island and Cape Cod tomorrow.

Day 2

After an included breakfast this morning, we continue our journey to Newport, RI, the "Ocean State." We'll start with an included lunch before we meet our local guide. Enjoy the charm of Newport's historic buildings and restored homes on this narrated tour covering over 150 points of interest. Take in the rugged beauty of Ten-Mile

Ocean Drive and the fabulous mansions along tree-lined Bellevue Avenue. Admission is included for a self-guided tour of the Breakers Mansion. The Breakers is the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial preeminence in turn of the century America. This afternoon we will depart for Cape Cod, and check into our home for the next four nights, the newly opened Margaritaville Resort. Your getaway starts the moment you step through the doors of Margaritaville Resort Cape Cod, where you'll discover a nautical-inspired space with a timelessly tropical flair. Dinner is included this evening at the resort.

Day 3

After an included breakfast at our resort, we will meet our **local guide** and travel historic Route 6A winding through centuries of Cape Cod history as we proceed to the **Cape Cod National Seashore in Provincetown**. After lunch and time to explore on your own, we will board an excursion vessel for an amazing experience of **whale watching**. We will travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment including birds that migrate here from all over the Atlantic, and fish which use these shallow waters to feed. Try to spot Humpback, Minke and Fin whales. Don't worry – the onboard naturalist will help you know which whales are which. Dinner is included again this evening.

Day 4

This morning we can enjoy another included breakfast before our local guide meets us at the resort and we travel to Woods Hole. Based here is the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution (WHOI), a private, non-profit research facility dedicated to the study of Marine science and the education of marine scientists. It is the largest independent oceanographic institution in the world. It was WHOI's research vessel, the Knorr, that found the HMS Titanic, off the coast of Newfoundland in 1985. From there our whole motorcoach will board the Steamship Authority ferry to the island of Martha's Vineyard. Upon arrival, our guide will conduct a "Down Island" Tour. We will learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as you pass through the picturesque villages. There will be free time for lunch in the historic whaling town of Edgartown. We'll complete our day on the island in Oak Bluffs, strolling through "Cottage City" with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. We will enjoy another included dinner this evening before returning to the resort for the night.

Day 5

This morning there will be plenty of time to relax and enjoy another included breakfast before meeting our local guide to experience **Hyannis**. The beginning of our tour will include the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport, and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy Family. We will enjoy some free time and lunch on your own today on Main Street. From there we will visit the Cape Cod Maritime Museum where the Cape and Islands maritime past, present and future is celebrated. Experience our inspiring passion and respect for the sea and how it continues to shape Cape Cod. After that we will visit the Whydah Pirate Museum. The Whydah was a fully rigged galley ship that was built by the British. During one of its voyages in 1717, it was captured by the famed pirate Samuel "Black Sam" Bellamy. During an infamous storm off the coast of Cape Cod the Whydah sank, laying its treasure just 500 feet off the shore for over 300 years. Now you can touch and see the world's only authenticated pirate treasure. Tonight's included lobster dinner is a must for any East Coast experience- don't worry, there are other choices for landlubbers.

Day 6

After our included breakfast at the resort, it's time to pack our things and head for Albany, NY where we will take a **scenic cruise down the Hudson River**. While we enjoy a light lunch, we will learn about notable sights in Albany as we enjoy scenic views and music. We end our evening in Auburn, New York with an included dinner.

Day 7
